FINISHING WITH HOT STAMPING FOILS: How to make **VECTOR** files 4-Color-Black (400% Black) in **PHOTOSHOP**

PRINT FILE PREPARATION:

STEP 1: NEW DOCUMENT SET-UP FOR CMYK:

- $| \mathbf{V} |$ Open Photoshop.
- ∇ Create a "New Document".
- \checkmark Search for "Color Mode" and Choose "CMYK Color".
- $|\sqrt{}|$ Click "OK".

PRINT FILE PREPARATION:

STEP 2: MAKE VECTOR FILES 4-COLOR BLACK (400% BLACK)

- Import Vector File: Choose "**File**" and "**Open**". Search for your vector file and click "**Open**".
- 2 Import options: Mode: Choose "CMYK Color" & Click "OK". See image 1.
- 3 When the document is open: Choose "**Select**" from the top menu and Click "**All**" or **Ctrl+A** on a Windows PC. See Image 2.
- 4 With the image selected, click "Edit" and choose "Copy" or Ctrl+C on a Windows PC.
- 5 Click back to the New Document (See image 2) & Paste your image into the new document by Clicking "**Edit**" and Choose "**Paste**" or **Ctrl**+**V** on a Windows PC.
- Scale image if needed. See image
 3. Click "Edit" and Choose "Free Transform" or Ctrl+T on a Windows PC.

FLAT IMAGES: REPEAT STEPS 7-15 BELOW

- 7 Find the Layer Pallette & Create a New Layer. See Images 4.
- 8 Right-Click on the New Layer & Choose "**Create Clipping Mask**". See Images 5 & 6.
- 9 Now Click "Edit" and choose "Fill". See Image 2. Note: make sure the new layer is still selected!! See Image 6.

SCALE IMAGE: CTRL+T



RIGHT-CLICK HERE & CHOOSE "CREATE CLIPPING MASK"

CLICK HERE TO CREATE A NEW LAYER



CLIPPING MASK LAYER SELECTED



Change the "Contents" option to "Colors..." (The "Color Picker (Fill Color)"

window now opens)

- Next, Change all the CMYK values to 100%. (*Image 7*) Click "**OK**" & then click "**OK**" again.
- 12

Your Vector image is now 4-Color Black (400% Black).



- Select all the Layers. See Image 8.
- 14

Right-Click on the Layers and Click "**Merge Layers**". See Image 8 & 9.



Save your file and your done.

FINISHING WITH HOT STAMPING FOILS: How to make **FLAT IMAGE** files 4-Color-Black (400% Black) in **PHOTOSHOP**



PRINT FILE PREPARATION:

STEP 1: HOW TO MAKE FLAT IMAGES 4-COLOR BLACK (400% BLACK)?

- Import Vector File: Choose "**File**" and "**Open**". Search for your file and click "**Open**".
- 2 Image options: Mode: Choose "CMYK Color" & Click "OK". See image 1.
- 3 When the document is open: Find the "**Wand Tool**" (*Image* 3). Change Sample Size to "**3 by 3 Average**" and Tolerance to "**20**" or more.
- 4 With the Wand Tool selected, click on the White areas of the image. This will not select all white areas. See Image 4.
- 5 To select all white areas, Choose "Select" from the top menu and click "Similar". Now all the White Areas are selected.
- 6 Now delete the white background by Choosing "**Edit**" and clicking "**Clear**".
 - Next, repeat <u>Steps 7 to 15 above</u>.
